



Guidelines for Speakers

BASIC INFORMATION

Your abstract has been accepted for ORAL presentation – congratulations! But what does this mean?

- You need to register for Workshop participation.
- You need to produce a full paper and a presentation.

DEADLINES – NO EXTENSION POSSIBLE

- **One author** per paper **must register** for the workshop. As a **speaker**, you are eligible for a special reduced participation fee. For fees, visit: <https://hybridpowersystems.org/tickets/>.
- To secure your presentation slot in the program, speakers and poster presenters must register **until 9 March 2026**. If registration is not possible until **9 March 2026** due to exceptional circumstances, please [contact the organizing team](#) so we can find a solution to keep your contribution in the program.
- The full paper and the signed & scanned copyright form must be submitted until **15 April 2026** via the online conference platform: <https://coms.app/hybridworkshop2026/>
- Your presentation (.ppt / .pptx) must be submitted until **30 May 2026 in your account** in the online conference platform. You will be informed separately, how updates of your presentations can be dealt with.

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING THE PAPER

TEMPLATES AND DATA FORMAT

- **Word and LaTeX** templates can be downloaded there. These templates are based on the IET paper template in the paper **format of DIN A4**. Please use these templates as basis for your paper.
- Data format: Word (.docx, A4) or PDF (600 dpi, open/without security restrictions) / images need to be of sufficient quality for printing

MINIMUM NUMBER OF PAGES

- The full paper of a speaker must have the minimum number of pages: **3**

ORTHOGRAPHIC NOTE OF THE EDITOR

In order to harmonise the different versions for the proceedings we kindly ask you to use the following spelling versions:

- When referring to MODELLING/MODELING use the British spelling **MODELLING** (double LL).
- When referring to FARMS/POWER PLANTS use the term **POWER PLANTS** – at least in the paper title.

GRAPHICS

- The manuscript's graphics should have resolutions of 600 dpi for monochrome, 300 dpi for grayscale, and 300 dpi for colors.
- Graphics should be inserted into the manuscript file rather than using copy and paste.
- Do not link to a graphic but insert the graphic into the manuscript instead.

FONTS

- The manuscript must use fonts that allow embedding and subsetting (including the base fonts). Failure to embed and subset fonts is the biggest obstacle to prepare a proper printable PDF file.
- All Type 1 fonts are embeddable. Only some TrueType fonts are embeddable. Do not embed fonts in a graphic file.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CREATING PDF FILES

- DO NOT use password protection in the PDF file.
- All fonts, including the standard (base) fonts, must be embedded and subsetted in the PDF.
- In "Settings -> Job Options -> Compression" of Writer/Distiller set the downsampling resolution to 600 dpi for monochrome, 300 dpi for grayscale, and 300 dpi for color.

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING THE PRESENTATION SLIDE DECK

- Prepare your presentation as **pptx-file** – for a smooth run of the event, other formats will be converted to pptx.
- You can use your own company layout for the PowerPoint presentation.
- For your presentation please, use an **aspect ratio** of **16:9**

- For last minute updates, you will be informed separately on alternative upload procedures.

REGISTRATION

- As a **speaker** you are eligible for a special reduced registration fee as long as you register by **9 March 2026**.
- As a **student**, you are entitled either to the "Student" (if under 26) or the "Academics" discount. You may choose the lowest fee applicable in the respective time scheme.
